Work continuing on the bus layover at Blacktown from 9 January 2023

December 2022

Construction of the new bus layover facility at Sunnyholt Road and Gordon Street, Blacktown started in September. The facility is needed to provide additional bus holding capacity to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services while easing congestion for all road users.

What are we doing?

Work will continue from 9 January to carry out the following:

- construction of bus layover pavement
- · drivers' amenities building fit out
- relocation of gas / water services and upgrade stormwater drainage system in Gordon Street
- Telstra service work at Gordon Street (potential non-noisy night works)
- reconstruction of Gordon Street Road pavement

Our work schedule

Work will start from Monday 9 January to Friday 31 March.

We will work mostly during the day. Where daytime work is not possible, then we will work during the night.

Day hours - 7am - 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am - 1pm on Saturday Night hours - 8pm - 5am Sunday to Thursday

We will not work on public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance where possible, including turning off equipment when not in use and completing the noisier tasks before midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures to the T-Way during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. However, bus services will remain unaffected. Access for residents and other road users will be always maintained on the T-Way and Gordon Street. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
