

Work continuing on the Bus Layover at Sunnyholt Road and Gordon Street at Blacktown from 18 October

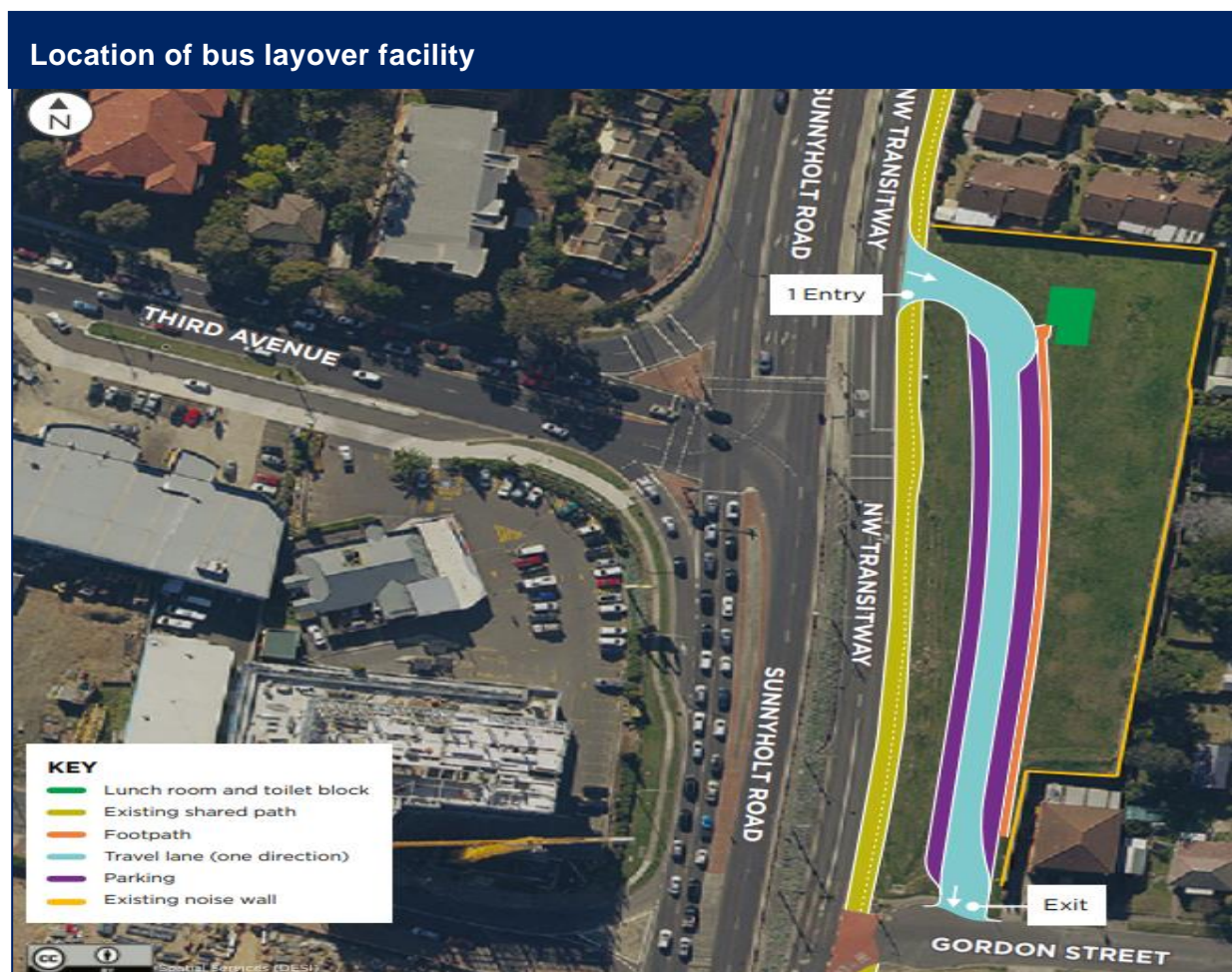

The NSW Government is funding a new bus layover facility at Blacktown as part of the Bus Priority Infrastructure Program, which aims to improve the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion for all road users.

What are we doing?

We will carry out the following works:

- bulk earthworks including disposal of spoil
- stormwater drainage
- pavement base preparation and minor retaining wall works
- drivers' amenities building foundations and structure
- relocation of Endeavour Energy electrical services (adjacent to T-way)
- relocation of gas main and installation of new water main (Gordon St)



Our work schedule

We will work **Tuesday 18 October to Friday 23 December** mostly during the day. Where daytime work is not possible, then we will work during the night.

Day work

7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturday.

Night work

Residents will be notified in advance of any night work.

Night work will be between Sunday and Thursday, from **8pm to 5am**.

Noisier tasks will be completed before midnight.

We will not work on public holidays

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance where possible, including turning off equipment when not in use and completing the noisier tasks before midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary lane closures to the T-Way during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. However, bus services will remain unaffected. Access for residents, pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles will be maintained at all times on the T-Way and Gordon Street. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
