

# F6 Extension Stage 1 – Utility and Geotechnical investigations

The NSW government is progressing with the development of the F6 Extension Stage 1 between the New M5, Arncliffe and President Avenue, Kogarah.

Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out utility investigations to gather information about utilities within the F6 Extension Stage 1 project area. The work will take place along West Botany Street, between Bermill Street and President Avenue, Kogarah.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

We will be working up to **six night shifts** from **Monday 5 February** until **Wednesday 14 February 2018**, weather permitting. Work will take place between **9pm and 4am** from **Monday to Wednesday**.

## How will the work affect you?

The utility investigation work will involve a variable message sign (VMS) mounted truck travelling along West Botany Street. The truck will stop at regular intervals for a team of surveyors to gather information about the utilities on West Botany Street.

The utility investigations will be carried out in multiple locations along West Botany Street and we expect the investigations to take less than 10 minutes at each location.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes in place to ensure the work zone is safe.

Rolling lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. There are no planned lane closures for day time work. Please keep to speed limits and follow the roadwork signage.
