

M6 Stage 1

Decommissioning underground fuel tanks at 736 Princes Highway, Kogarah from Monday 14 September 2020



The M6 Stage 1 will connect President Avenue at Kogarah to the M8 at Arncliffe, connecting southern Sydney to the wider motorways network.

From Monday 14 September 2020, we will decommission the underground fuel tanks at the former 7-Eleven service station and install monitoring equipment in and around the site so that we can make the site safe and ready for construction of the M6 Stage 1 project.

We will continue to keep you updated as we progress our work at the site. Our work area is shown on the map over the page.

What does our work involve?

Our work involves locating underground fuel tanks, disconnecting services and decommissioning underground tanks.

We will remove any leftover fuel from the tanks and fill them with foam to make them safe.

We will also install ground monitoring equipment and take samples to help us understand the ground conditions and the potential impacts from the previous operation of the 7-Eleven service station.

We will also be including security cameras to protect our property and equipment.

We will be using light vehicles, liquid foam, delivery trucks, scanning equipment, concrete saw, hand tools, compressors and an excavator to complete the work.

Our work schedule

Our work will take up to eight weeks to complete, weather permitting. Our work hours are:

Day work: 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday 8am to 1pm, Saturday

We will not be working public holidays.

How will our work affect you?

Our work is expected to create some noise. We will reduce our noise by turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used.

There may also be a small amount of odour as we carry out our work on the fuel tanks.

For the safety of our workers and the community, there will be traffic control and exclusion zones in place during our work. We ask that pedestrians and motorists take care when navigating around our work area.

The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. Our people are following hygiene and appropriate social distancing measures and will continue to do so.

Currently, our infrastructure construction projects are considered essential to the economy and will continue as planned across the city and state.

The M6 Stage 1 project will deliver 5,300 jobs and support the local economy.

Location of work at 736 Princes Highway, Kogarah





