



M6 Stage 1

Night work for utility investigations at Princes Highway and President Avenue, Kogarah from Tuesday 14 September 2021

Recently the M6 Stage 1 team notified you about utility investigations taking place in your area. To view the original notification please go to the M6 Stage 1 interactive portal. The notifications can be found at <https://caportal.com.au/rms/m6/map#>

We are starting night work for these utility investigations near your residence at Princes Highway and President Avenue from **Tuesday 14 September to Tuesday 21 September between 9pm and 5am**, weather permitting. Our contingency dates will be Wednesday 22 September to Wednesday 29 September, should there be weather or site delays. A map of our work area is shown over the page.

What does our work involve?

Our work involves using ground-penetrating radars (GPR) and digging under the road surface (slot trenching) to locate existing utilities under the ground.

Our work will include:

- scanning the roads and footpaths using a GPR
- collecting information to help locate utility services and connections
- setting up the investigation area in a safe work area
- removing a small section of ground material using a concrete saw
- using a vacuum truck to suck the dirt out of the ground
- identifying the utilities
- using underground pipeline CCTV investigations
- reinstating the area.

We are required to conduct this work at night to avoid interruptions to traffic along this important roadway.

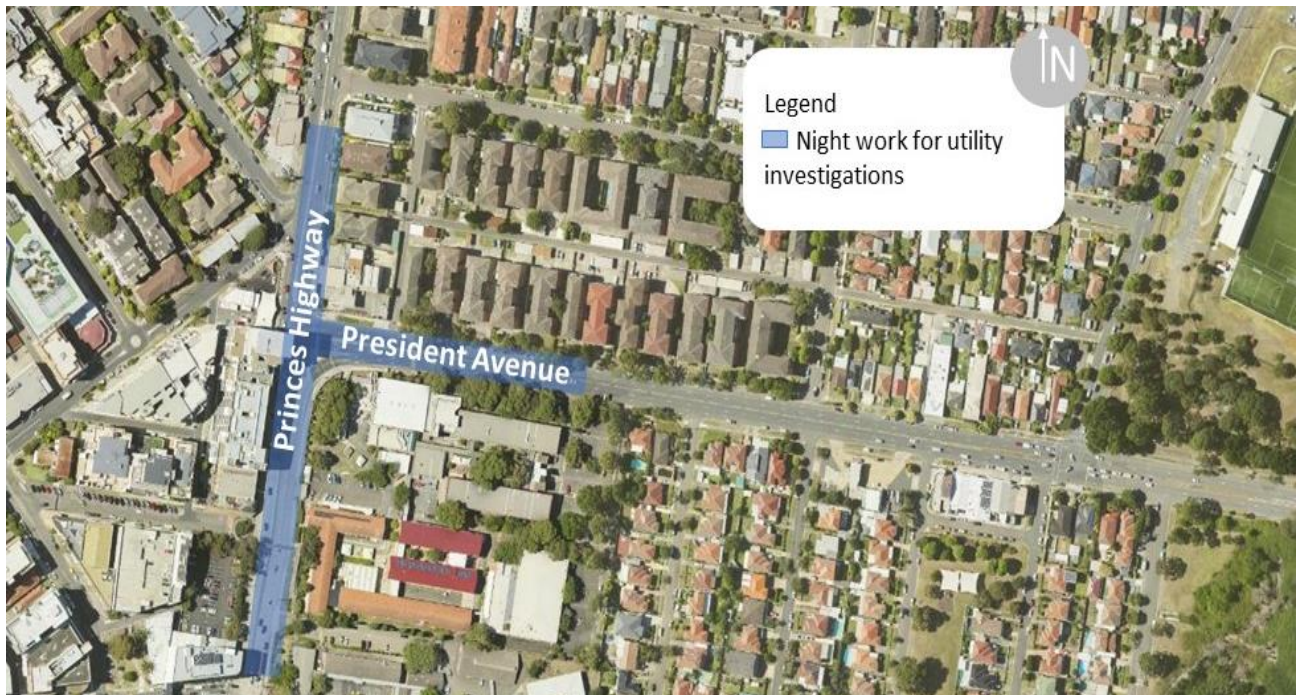
How will our work affect you?

On Tuesday 14 September and Wednesday 15 September, our work is not expected to create noise.

Our noisy work will take place on Thursday 16 September, Friday 17 September, Monday 20 September and Tuesday 21 September.

We will aim to complete the noisiest work before midnight. We will endeavour to minimise the impact on nearby residents by turning off our machinery when not in use and using noise insulation blankets on our temporary fencing. We will also ensure compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management. Our project team will complete the work as quickly as possible to reduce any inconvenience to residents.

The safety and wellbeing of the wider community and our workers is our highest priority. We are working closely with our contractors to make sure COVID safe plans are in place including following appropriate hygiene and social distancing measures.
