Start of work on Medlow Bath Station upgrade from Monday 12 December 2022

Together, the Australian Government and the NSW Government are investing more than \$2.5 billion towards upgrading the East and West Sections of the Great Western Highway between Katoomba and Lithgow.

Transport for NSW is starting early work in the railway corridor at Medlow Bath as part of the Great Western Highway Upgrade. Early work includes minor vegetation trimming and the relocation of the existing rail boundary fence along the Great Western Highway at Medlow Bath.

Vegetation trimming will occur around the rail corridor boundary fence between the Medlow Bath Station Level Crossing and the Rail Access Gate opposite United Petroleum to remove the existing fence and install a new one.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday** with early works being completed in **February 2023**, weather permitting. We will continue to update the community as the project progresses.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by undertaking the works during the day and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. All work will occur within the rail corridor and will not impact pedestrian access or the Great Western Highway.

Traffic changes
