

Manly Cove Investigation works from Monday 14 February

The iconic Manly waterfront is set to become more accessible to the public as the NSW Government progresses plans to improve accessibility to Wharf 3 and enhance the area of the former Sea Life site at Manly Cove.

Transport for NSW will be conducting an overhead drone survey and marine ecology surveys at Manly Wharf 3 and former Manly Sea Life site. The information gathered during this work will provide an understanding of the existing environmental conditions.

The drone will be operated under Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) Permission to Operate in Restricted Areas.

Our work schedule

The work is expected to be carried out over a **two-week** period from **Monday 14 February**, weather permitting.

Works will occur between **7am** and **6pm Monday** to **Friday**. No works will be carried out on weekends or Public Holidays.

How our work may impact you

During the investigations the wharves will remain open. Safety protocols will be in place throughout these investigations, and any changes will be communicated with relevant operators and stakeholders.

There will be minimal noise associated with these works, we will do everything we can to minimise impacts.

Concept design consultation update

Consultation on the proposed concept for Manly Wharf 3 upgrade and former Sea Life site closed late January and we will be releasing the consultation report soon. Also, we will be in touch with an update on the next phase of the project, which involves seeking community feedback on the environmental assessment.
