

Newell Highway overtaking lanes work continues


The Newell Highway Program Alliance will start building the overtaking lanes at Marthaguy from Monday 27 May. Work will also continue on the overtaking lanes at Dustys Creek.

What are we doing?

Marthaguy

Initial work will start on the overtaking lanes at Marthaguy from Monday 27 May. The work will include establishing the site compound, installing fencing, removing trees, and erosion and sediment control.

Building the Marthaguy overtaking lanes will take about nine months to complete, weather permitting.







Dustys Creek

In the meantime, work will continue at Dustys Creek and will include removing trees, barriers placement and line marking, excavation and drainage work.

Work on the Dustys Creek overtaking lanes will take about eight months to complete, weather permitting.



Work at Marthaguy and Dustys Creek will be carried out between 7am and 6pm weekdays and 8am and 1pm Saturdays, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to work outside these times.

What you need to know

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40 km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.
