

Work on the overtaking lanes at Dustys Creek, north of Gilgandra, to continue

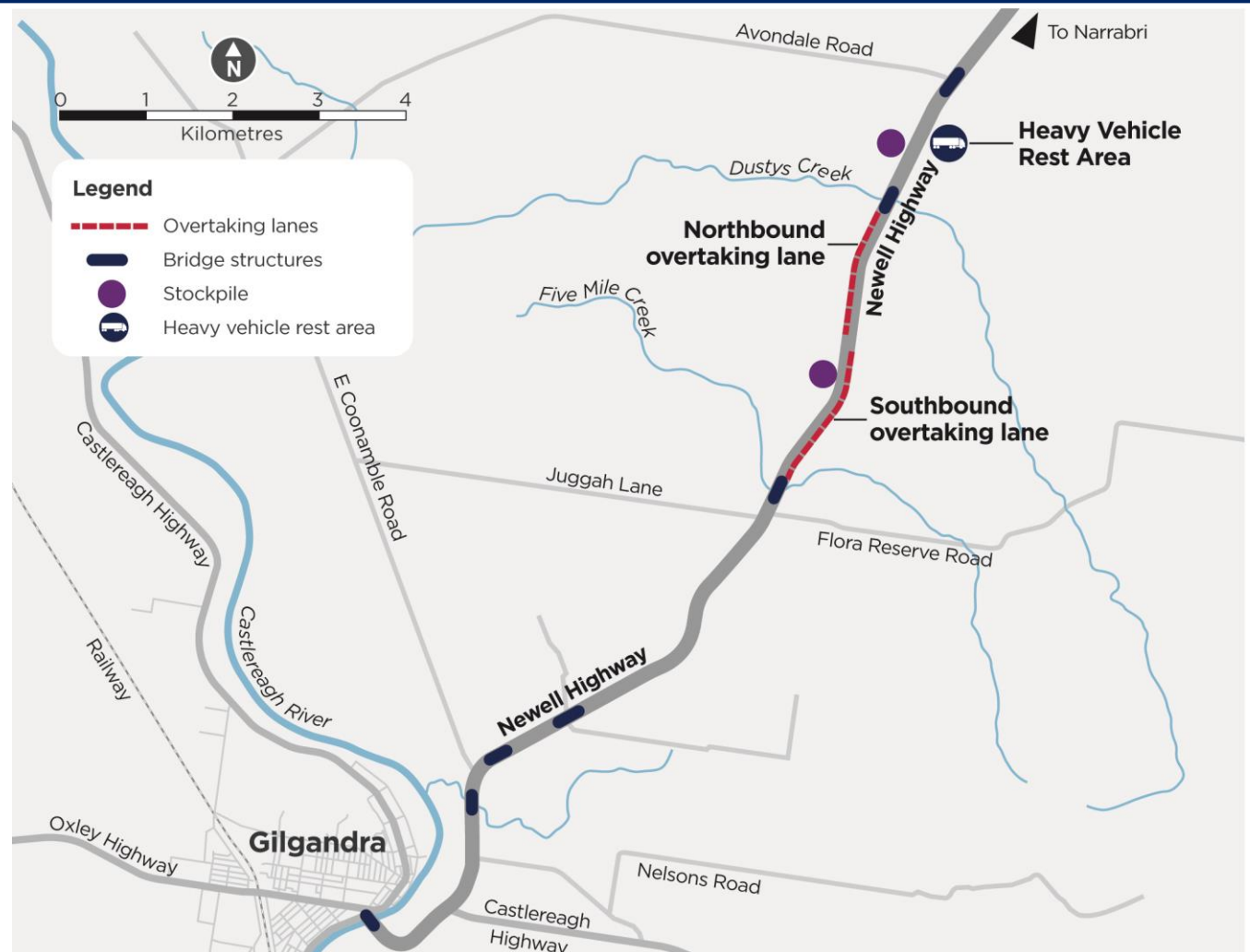
The Newell Highway Program Alliance will restart work on the overtaking lanes at Dustys Creek from early May 2019. These are the first overtaking lanes to be delivered by the Alliance.

What are we doing?

Initial work on the Dustys Creek overtaking lanes started in March 2019. This work included establishing the site compound, installation of fencing, some tree removal, erosion and sediment control.

In May 2019, work will continue and will include drainage work, earthwork and excavation work.

This work will take eight months to complete. Work will be carried out between **7am and 6pm** weekdays and **7am and 2pm** Saturdays starting from **Monday 6 May**, weather permitting.

What you need to know

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40 km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.
