Early works for Denmark Link Road from 7 September


Community update | September 2022

Transport for NSW (Transport) is continuing work on the North West Growth Area Road Network Strategy. Planning for Denmark Link Road upgrade project is now complete, and we are moving into construction with the start of early works.

The Denmark Link Road project includes constructing the missing local road connections between Garfield Road West, Riverstone and Bridge Street, Schofields.

Transport for NSW consulted with the community in December 2020 on the Review of Environmental Factors and concept design for the Denmark Link Road project. The submissions report, which summarises and responds to the community's feedback for this project is available online at nswroads.work/denmarkrd.

Transport has engaged Ausconnex to carry out early works on the project. Over the next four months, Ausconnex will prepare the project area for roadworks by clearing vegetation and upgrading the existing street light network by installing new street lights.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for 50 day shifts from Wednesday 7 September until Friday 16 December, weather permitting. Our work hours will be 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance on surrounding residents and businesses. Any high noise impact works such as vegetation clearing will be undertaken during the permitted work hours.

To carry out this work, we will need to remove any items that are located on boundaries outside of residential properties and on council-owned land. Residents are asked to remove and relocate any items outside of their property boundaries. This may include horses, materials, motor vehicles and other equipment.

Traffic changes

Most of the work will take place in the road reserve. There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions. Access to residential properties will always be maintained.
