



# Transport Access Program

## Croydon Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

OCTOBER – NOVEMBER 2017

Works are nearing completion for the Croydon Station Upgrade. The project includes the provision of two new lifts and stairs, a new pedestrian footbridge, improved shelter, new bicycle racks and upgrades to lighting and CCTV surveillance.

### Upcoming construction activities:

Works over the coming weeks will include:

- completion of works to the new concourse
- works to Platform 1/2 including stairway and services installation
- stormwater drainage system and fire hydrant installation
- platform reinstatement and finishing works
- road and footpath works on Paisley Road near The Strand.

### Night works

#### Transfer of construction plant and equipment

Transfer of construction plant and equipment from the site compound on Paisley Road to platforms 3 and 4 is required as part of platform reinstatement works. The safest way to transfer equipment is at night when trains are not operational. This is planned to be undertaken between **midnight to 3am on Saturday 28 October 2017**. Access into the rail corridor will be via the rail access gate on the intersection of Paisley Road and Edwin Street South. Movement of equipment will be kept to a minimum and every effort will be made to minimise noise. Following the platform reinstatement works, the excavator will be removed from platforms 3 and 4 between the hours of **midnight and 3 am on one night from Wednesday 1 November to Saturday 11 November 2017**. Additional notification will be provided to nearby residents at least 24 hours prior to the activities commencing.

#### Installation of glazing and pedestrian crossing reinstatement works – Hennessy Street

To minimise disruption to customers and road users, installation of glazing and reinstatement of the line marking on the pedestrian crossing on the intersection of Hennessy Street and Meta Street will be carried out at night. Works will occur on the following nights:

- **8pm Wednesday 8 November to 5am Thursday 9 November 2017**

- **8pm Thursday 9 November to 5am Friday 10 November 2017**
- **8pm Monday 13 November to 5am Tuesday 14 November 2017**
- **8pm Tuesday 14 November to 5am Wednesday 15 November 2017.**

During these works **the stairs leading to Platform 5 will be closed to customers** for installation of the glazing. Access to Platform 5 will be via the lift.

**From 10pm Monday 13 November to 5am Tuesday 14 November 2017, Hennessy Street will close between College Street and Meta/Young Street** to ensure the safety of workers and the community during the reinstatement of the line marking. Traffic control personnel will be on duty to assist vehicle and pedestrian movements. Machinery will be turned off when not in use and construction vehicle movements will be kept to a minimum to reduce noise.

### **Upcoming weekend works**

Works are planned over the following weekends in order to enable construction works to be undertaken safely and to minimise disruption to customers:

- **8am to 6pm on Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 October 2017**
- **8am to 6pm Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 November 2017**
- **8am to 6pm Saturday 11 and Sunday 12 November 2017.**

Key activities will include kerb and footpath realignment works on Paisley Road and finishing works on the new concourse and stairs including electrical works and painting.

### **What might I notice?**

You may notice workers within the rail corridor, on the station platforms, Paisley Road and on Hennessy Street.

Plant and equipment which may be used during the construction period includes semi-trailers, excavators, platform ladders, rattle guns, concrete saws, concrete truck and pump, elevated work platforms, jackhammers, compactors, generators, light towers and hand and power tools.

### **Standard construction hours**

Work will continue during standard construction hours which are **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. Additional notification of any works outside of these hours will be provided to the community prior to those works commencing. Every effort will be made to minimise the noise impact on nearby residents and businesses. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience as works near completion.
