

STAGED OPENING OF NEW FACILITIES NEW CONCOURSE, LIFTS AND STAIRS OPENING END OF SEPTEMBER 2017

The Transport Access Program is a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern and integrated transport infrastructure.

New station facilities opening

As part of the Croydon Station Upgrade, new station facilities will be opened to the community from the **end of September 2017**. This will include:

- new station concourse
- lifts and stairs to platforms 3/4 and 5
- station office and family accessible toilet
- new station entrances on Paisley Road and Hennessy Street
- · reinstatement of kiss and ride on Hennessy Street.

The map over the page outlines the new station facilities to be opened to the public.

Upon opening the new station facilities, the following access changes will be implemented:

- the temporary station office will be closed
- the temporary pedestrian crossing on Paisley Road will be closed to pedestrians
- access to platforms 3 and 4 via the temporary footbridge and access to Platform 5 from Paisley Road will be closed to commuters.


The temporary footbridge will be removed in **early October 2017**. A detailed notification outlining these works will be issued closer to the time of work.

From **November 2017**, additional station facilities will become available. This includes the stairs to Platform 1/2, parking spaces including two new accessible parking spaces, kiss and ride and bike parking facility on Paisley Road, and the footpath on Meta Street Bridge.



Upcoming weekend works

Further to our previous notifications, weekend works will occur between 8am Saturday 23 September to 6pm Sunday 24 September 2017. During this time, Hennessy Street will close from 10pm Saturday 23 September to 6am Sunday 24 September 2017 between College Street and Meta/Young Street to allow for pavement resurfacing works. Traffic diversions will be in place via College, Edwin Street North, Anthony, Young and Meta streets. Access to residential and commercial properties will be maintained with traffic controllers on duty to assist.



Equipment to be used will include elevated work platforms, excavators, compactors, rollers, hand and power tools, mobile generators and line marking equipment.

Works may be noisy at times. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to nearby residents and businesses.

Standard construction hours

Work will continue during standard construction hours which are **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday 8am to 1pm.** Additional notification of any works outside of these hours will be provided to the community prior to those works commencing.
