Harris Park Station Upgrade

The Transport Access Program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Project Overview

Work is progressing with new stairs recently installed to platforms 3 and 4, and scaffolding erected for the lift shaft. The footpath upgrade from Station Street East to Cambridge Street will continue, with the final stage between Marion Street and Harris Park station remaining closed until later this month. Please allow extra travel time, and follow directional signage.

Upcoming out of hours work

From 2am Saturday 9 September to 2am Monday 11 September 2017

Work has been planned during a scheduled Sydney Trains shutdown on platforms 3 and 4, to provide safe access for workers and minimise disruption to rail users. The work over the weekend will include the installation of footbridge canopies, concourse roofing work, services installation to platforms 3 and 4, and craning of materials onto the station platform.

Temporary changes to access

To enable the establishment and operation of a crane on Station Street West, the following temporary changes will be in place.

- Access to the footbridge from Station Street West will be CLOSED to pedestrians. An alternate
 pedestrian route, via Cambridge Street, is indicated on the map on the following page.
- Station Street West will be closed to traffic from Cambridge Street to Marion Street, with residents only access. Traffic control will be in place to allow safe access for residents, and to direct traffic around the detour. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Commuters can access trains running from platforms 1 and 2 from the east ramp via
 Cambridge Street. An alternate pedestrian route is indicated on the map overleaf.

Standard construction hours

Other construction on the Harris Park Station Upgrade will continue throughout the month during standard working hours, which are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Any works occurring outside these standard hours will notified for prior to works commencing.
