**Edgecliff Station Upgrade** 

#### **COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION**

**JULY - AUGUST 2018** 

The Transport Access Program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.



## **Project overview**

Transport for NSW is upgrading Edgecliff Station to make it more user-friendly and easier for everyone to access.

Key features of the station upgrade include:

- Two new lifts will provide access to the train platforms and the bus interchange
- Four escalator replacements between the train platforms and concourse
- · Relocated ticket gates to improve customer flow
- New kiss and ride zone on New McLean Street
- Improved pedestrian access and safety in the bus interchange with introduction of pedestrian crossings.

### **Project update**

The site compound on the bus interchange is currently being established. Construction work on the platforms will commence shortly. Construction works during August will be noisy due to the construction of the new lift shaft and fire stairs from the platforms to the concourse. The construction works will also include:

- Installation of hoarding for the construction zones on the platforms and,
- The preparation of the site for construction, which will require the removal of built up dust and dirt from ceilings. This work will be undertaken out of hours to minimise disruptions and ensure the safe removal of these materials.

These construction works will include the delivery of concrete and materials and the use of power tools. The timing and dates of these works have been outlined below.

Every effort will be made to minimise the noise impact on customers, local businesses and residents.

We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your cooperation during these important works

To understand the extent of the noise, the project will also be undertaking noise monitoring in the first couple of weeks of construction.

Train services will remain fully operational during August.

### Notice of out of hours works

#### From Monday 30 July to Friday 3 August

As mentioned in the July notification there will be out of hour works from **Monday July 30 to Friday August 3.** During this period rail track machinery will be used **between the hours of 11pm and 3am.** Rail track machinery is required to transport new building materials to the platforms. Works will also include concrete delivery and pouring and other onsite works. These works will be noisy at times.

#### From Sunday 5 August to Thursday 30 August

Regular night works will be taking place from **Sunday 5 of August to Thursday 30 of August between 6pm and 7am.** This will include the start of construction for the new lift shaft and fire stairs from the platform to the concourse. To undertake these works there will be the delivery of concrete and materials which may be noisy at times.

All other works during this period will be undertaken on the station platform and these works will be inaudible outside the station building.

#### Standard construction hours

There will be work undertaken throughout the month during standard working hours, which are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm Saturday**. These works will include the start of construction for the new lift shaft and fire stairs from the platform to the concourse which will involve the use of power tools including jackhammers and concrete saws. Hoarding will be in place to minimise noise and ensure continued customer access.

Notifications of any works occurring outside of these standard hours will be given prior to works commencing.
