

Transport Access Program Edgecliff Station Upgrade

Community notification - planning approval



The Transport Access Program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Planning approval

Planning approval has now been received for Edgecliff Station Upgrade.

Customers are set to benefit from better access to transport facilities following planning approval for the Edgecliff Station Upgrade project.

The project includes:

- Installation of a new lift from the bus interchange to the concourse level via the shops/gallery, and an additional new lift which connects the paid concourse to the station platform
- Replacement of the existing four escalators to the station platform with new escalators
- Construction of new fire stairs between the station platform and paid concourse
- Relocation of the existing ticket gates and installation of around four additional gates

- Bus interchange; Installation of new pedestrian crossings and ramps, to provide an accessible path of travel from the new lift to the existing bus stands, installation of additional wind breaks on the bus islands, and relocation of the bicycle shed within the bus interchange to improve pedestrian movements between the lift and the bus stands
- Provision of three new kiss and ride spaces on New McLean Street, plus sheltered seating and the installation of a new undercover bicycle rack, and modification of the pedestrian access ramp to provide an accessible path of travel between the street and the station concourse
- Additional works including adjustments to lighting, electrical upgrades, minor drainage, new seating, improvements to CCTV security, hearing loops, wayfinding signage and installation of tactile ground surface indicators.



Feedback from the community

Thank you to the community members who provided feedback on the plan and those who took the time to visit our pop up kiosk at the station. All submissions received during the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors were considered as part of the planning approval process and have been addressed in a Determination Report.

Key themes raised by the community included:

- Support for the project and improvements to accessibility
- Potential traffic impacts associated with the location of the kiss and ride on New McLean Street. Transport for NSW is working closely with RMS and Woollahra Municipal Council to find a solution for this intersection, with parking on New McLean Street set to be restricted on approach to New South Head Road during peak times.
- Enquiries regarding construction staging and possible construction impacts.

Next Steps

Construction is scheduled to commence in mid-2018. It is expected that the upgrade will be delivered in stages to ensure customers have access to the new facilities as soon as they are available.
