Edgecliff Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

The Transport Access Program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.



Project overview

Transport for NSW is upgrading Edgecliff Station to make it more user-friendly and easier for everyone to access.

Key features of the station upgrade include:

- Two new lifts will provide access to the train platforms and the bus interchange
- Four escalator replacements between the train platforms and concourse
- Relocated ticket gates to improve customer flow
- New kiss and ride zone on New McLean Street
- Improved pedestrian access and safety in the bus interchange with introduction of pedestrian crossings.

Project update

Site investigation works are continuing around the station, including near retail and within the bus interchange. In the coming weeks, there will again be an increase in construction personnel around the station. July works will consist of the following:

- establishment of temporary construction fencing within the bus interchange to demarcate site storage and construction staff facilities, resulting in some minor changes to bicycle path and pedestrian access
- · continuing non-disruptive investigations of station facilities throughout day and night periods
- irregular temporary systems shutdown during station closure at night.

There will be no impact on station operations as a result of these works.

Notice of out of hours works

Site investigation activities will continue between the hours of **8pm and 5am nightly (Sunday to Thursday inclusive)** throughout the month of July. The reason the works are being done outside standard working hours is to reduce the impact on rail customers. These works will be inaudible outside the station building.

It is anticipated that weeknight works will also occur 30/07/18 to 03/08/18. Further details on these works will be provided in the August community notification.

Standard construction hours

Regular construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Notifications of any other works occurring outside of these standard hours will be given prior to works commencing.
