Upcoming weekend and night work

From 2am Saturday 7 September to 2am Monday 9 September

To ensure the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. No train services will be operating this weekend. Please contact Transport Info on **131 500** or visit <u>transportnsw.info</u> for more information about replacement bus services.

Traffic control will be in place at the intersection of Ross Street and Burfitt Parade; on the southern side of Glenbrook Station, traffic control will be operational along Station Street. Pedestrian access will remain open in all areas and we ask that pedestrians follow direction from traffic controllers to ensure safety is maintained. Some of this work may be noisy at times and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.



Work activities in August included:

- continued progress on the Burfitt Parade station entry walkway and new stairs
- continued progress on the new unisex ambulant toilet
- continued construction of the brick façade around the lift shaft
- reinstatement of platform garden beds

Work planned for September include:

start of road work on Burfitt Parade

completion and opening of new stairs and closure of existing ramp

replacement of handrails on existing footbridge stairs

regrading of station platforms

installation of glass panels to the new canopy at the entrance to the new family accessible toilet continued fit out of lift

completion of new unisex ambulant toilet and start work on the family accessible toilet

installation of electrical and communication systems

ongoing installation and testing of a new station transformer

completion of stormwater and drainage work around the city end of the platform

continued progress on the station entry walkway

installation of external walls and handrails at the lift entrance

upgrade of tactile ground surface indicators on the platform to assist visually impaired customers.

Automatic Train Protection

Transport for NSW is boosting safety across the electrified rail network by delivering new Automatic Train Protection (ATP) technology. Over the weekend of 7-8 September, from 6am-6pm, additional ATP work will be undertaken to install new signalling equipment at Glenbrook Station. This work will include the use of a dump truck and excavator.

All work will occur within the rail corridor. Workers will access work areas via the gate adjacent to the corner of Station Street and Wright Street, and the gate on Deane Street.

We understand upgrades to the station can bring some inconvenience during construction and thank you for your patience during this time.
