Project update

The Glenbrook Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Activities in October included:

- continued work on the new family accessible toilet
- continued road work on Burfitt Parade
- · continued work on lift
- installation of upgraded power supply for improved safety and security
- installation of the external walls and handrails at the lift entrance
- replacement handrails on the existing footbridge stairs.

Work planned for November

During November, activities on the station upgrade will include:

- continued road work on Burfitt Parade, including the establishment of two new accessible parking spaces
- completion and opening of a new family accessible toilet
- completion of lift features and service testing
- testing of new electrical assets
- opening of new station stairs
- opening of new ramp connecting Burfitt Parade footpath to the station footbridge, and permanent closure of the existing ramp from early November.

Night work – Saturday 9 November to Monday 11 November

For the improved safety of our customers and staff, some night work will be undertaken this month during a scheduled Sydney Trains track work period, where no trains will be running. From **2am Saturday 9 November until 2am Monday 11 November,** our construction crew will be working to:

- paint the white safety strip onto the platform surface between the tactiles and platform edge
- remove the hoarding along the new access ramp walkway and around the lift on the platform
- install permanent fencing along new access ramp
- remove the generator from the platform
- · rectify defects on platforms

Hand tools will be used to complete some of these activities.

Standard working hours

Standard work hours are between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**. We will continue to inform the community ahead of any activities outside of standard work hours. We understand upgrades to the station can bring some inconvenience during construction and thank you for your patience during this time.
