

Transport Access Program

Bexley North Station Upgrade

Project Update

September 2019

The Transport Access program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Project overview

Planning approval was granted in April 2019 and preliminary design work is now underway on the Bexley North Station Upgrade. In order to progress the design, a suite of on-site investigative works are being undertaken and are expected to take about one month to complete.

Key features of the Bexley North Station Upgrade include

- a new lift and upgraded station entrance, stairs and canopy
- two new accessible parking spaces in the commuter car park
- new accessible pathways throughout the station precinct, including a new ramp to the commuter car park
- a new family accessible toilet and unisex ambulant toilet
- improvements to CCTV and lighting to increase safety and security
- reconfigured and upgraded commuter car park with a total of 22 spaces, increased aisle width, and space for vehicle turning.

Weekend work

Some weekend work will be undertaken this month outside of standard construction hours to improve the safety of customers and construction workers. Weekend work is to occur during a during scheduled Sydney Trains track work period, when no trains will be running. Please visit transportnsw.info or call **131 500** for up to date information regarding replacement buses during this time.

This work is scheduled to take place **between 6am and 6pm** on

- **Saturday 14 September, and**
- **Sunday 15 September.**

Work will occur predominantly under station stairs, on the station platform and within the rail corridor. Activities will include geotechnical investigations, underground service investigations, surveying and station building condition inspections. Equipment will include a vacuum truck, a small truck mounted geotechnical drilling rig, an elevated work platform, surveying equipment and hand tools.

Measures will be implemented wherever possible to reduce noise associated with this work, including switching off vehicles when not in use, using non-tonal reversing beepers, stopping work for respite periods and undertaking noise monitoring to ensure predicted noise levels are adhered to.
