

Transport Access Program Blackheath Station Upgrade



The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Blackheath Station

Investigations are currently underway to develop an early concept design for Blackheath Station to make it more accessible for all customers.

The early concept design includes:

- three new lifts to station entries and platforms
- upgrades to the existing accessible parking spaces, kiss and ride bay and taxi zone
- removal of the non-compliant pedestrian level crossing
- upgrades to station footpaths
- platform upgrades including new tactiles and installation of an accessible water fountain
- improvements to CCTV, lighting and wayfinding
- upgrades to the station footbridge and stairs
- provision of new bicycle hoops.


