The Transport Access Program is a Transport for NSW initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure. We are making great progress on the project, with the new lift opening in mid-February providing improved accessibility throughout the station precinct.

Project update and changes to pedestrian access

The opening of the new lift between the bus interchange, gallery and concourse delivers the first step in making Edgecliff Station more accessible and user friendly. March will see the re-opening of escalators 1 and 2 with construction work commencing on the relocation of the ticket gates and the New McLean Street ramp.

New Ticket Gates

Construction of the new ticket gate line will begin at the end of February. The new gates will be located closer to New South Head road, reducing congestion and improving flow into the station. Construction will be conducted at night to minimise disruption to commuters, with trenches being covered during the day to maintain safe access. Doors of new gates will be left in the open position before the old gates are removed. Commuters will continue through to tap their Opal or single use tickets at the existing gates.

New McLean Street Entry

From mid-March, work will commence on the New McLean Street entry. Signage will be installed in advance to notify commuters and pedestrians of upcoming changes, with alternate routes and dates. The four parking spaces on New McLean Street near the ramp will be unavailable from mid-march for a period of up to 10 weeks, from when they'll be converted to kiss and ride spaces. Signage will be installed to provide the community with plenty of notice prior to these spaces being taken.

Out of hours works

Night works will continue within station areas between **8pm** and **5am**, **Sunday** through **Thursday** throughout the month of March. Some deliveries and concrete pours are restricted to these night periods via New McLean Street and we will endeavour to limit the impact on surrounding residents. Noise mitigation measures such as respite periods during noisy activities will be utilised, and noise monitoring will be undertaken to ensure adherence with approved activities.

Standard construction hours

Standard working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm, Saturday. Works during these hours will occur behind the hoardings or temporary fencing. In consultation with local businesses and residents, we will aim to complete all major noisy works during these hours, including most material movements. Suitable respite periods and noise reduction methods will be used where possible.
