Project update

Work is progressing well at Hazelbrook Station with the completion of excavation for the new lift and the successful installation of ground anchors. In May, work will include the installation of reinforcement mesh in preparation for a concrete pour and the installation of the lift shaft.

Throughout May you may notice traffic control in place at the station and on surrounding streets. This is to safely direct pedestrians and traffic around the construction site.

Weekend work – 6am Friday 24 May to 4am Monday 27 May

From **6am Friday 24 May to 4am Monday 27 May** preparation, delivery and installation of lift shafts and lift landings will take place at Hazelbrook Station.

To ensure the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. No train services will be operating this weekend. Road Closures – Friday 24 May to Monday 27 May

From **6am Friday 24 May to 4am Monday 27 May** Railway Parade will be closed between Addington Road and Orama Road to non-residents vehicles, due to the presence of heavy vehicles and equipment to deliver and install the lift structures.

Detours will be in place and vehicles will have access to either side of the Railway Parade closure via the Great Western Highway.

In addition to the replacement bus services, other bus companies will be operating from a temporary bus stand on Great Western Highway. Signage will be installed to notify and direct the community and passengers of these changes. Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist with safe vehicle and pedestrian movements.

Car Park Closure – Friday 24 May to Monday 27 May

From **6am Friday 24 May to 6am Monday 27 May** there will be a temporary closure of 30 car parking spaces in the station car park to assist with these works. Entry to the car park via Railway Parade will be closed to traffic. The map below highlights the spaces that will be closed in green, and the road closure in red.

The car park will remain accessible via Addington Road. Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist with vehicle movements.

Footpath Closures – Friday 24 May to Monday 27 May

From **6am Friday 24 May to 6am Monday 27 May** access to the car park via Railway Parade will be closed. The footbridge across the Great Western Highway and footpaths along Railway Parade will be accessible with the aid of traffic controllers.

Signage will be installed to notify the community and passengers of these changes. Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist with safe vehicle and pedestrian movements.

What equipment will be used?

The equipment that will be used will include, but is not limited to generators, temporary lighting, cranes, scissor lifts, excavators, line pumps, trucks, heavy and light vehicles, power tools and hand tools.

Some of this work may be noisy. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to commuters, nearby residents and businesses. Noise monitoring will be undertaken to assess any impact.

Standard Working Hours

All other works will continue to be carried out during standard working hours which are between **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**. The community will be notified of any works outside these hours prior to the works commencing.
