

# Transport Access Program

**Como Station Upgrade** 

Project Update May 2020

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Como Station.

This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure



## **Project overview**

The Como Station Upgrade will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, carers/parents with prams and customers with luggage.

Key features of the station upgrade include:

- Two new lifts connecting the platform and commuter car park to the underpass
- Upgraded station entry at the commuter car park, including new stairs to connect to the underpass
- Relocation of the three existing accessible parking spaces closer to the new lifts
- Upgrades and regrading of the existing ramp from Railway Road
- A new accessible pathways throughout the station precinct
- Formalised kiss and ride zone on Railway Road
- Improved amenities such as new male and female ambulant toilets, a new family accessible toilet, CCTV and lighting
- New stairs to connect Como Parade to the underpass.

## **Project update**

From **Monday 11 May until Wednesday 20 May**, surveys and geotechnical investigations will be carried out in and around the station. The results from the investigations will help inform the final design of the project. These investigations have been scheduled to occur during standard construction hours and are not expected to impact station operations or the surrounding public.

Construction of the Como Station Upgrade is expected to commence in the coming months.

## Pedestrian access changes

The narrow path joining the eastern end of the carpark will be temporarily unavailable on Friday 15 May. Directional signage will be in place to help customers accessing the car park.

## Standard construction hours

Work will be undertaken during standard construction hours, which are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm Saturday**. Should work outside standard construction hours be needed, notification will be provided to the community prior to the work starting.
