


Transport Access Program Glenbrook Station Upgrade



Glenbrook Station Upgrade is now complete and the community is able to use the station's new and improved accessibility features.

Customers can use the new lift to access the station platform, footbridge and station amenities, including a new family accessible and an ambulant toilet.

CCTV, wayfinding and lighting have been improved to increase safety and security around the station precinct. The station entry and footpaths have been upgraded along with a formalised kiss and ride area on Burfitt Parade. Two accessible parking spaces within the commuter car park have also been improved.

The project was completed as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.



- Upgrade of the existing pedestrian crossing on Burfitt Parade
- Upgrades to CCTV and lighting for improved safety and security.
